Trash receptacles must be at the curb before 6:00 a.m. on scheduled pickup day. Place trash receptacles and recycling bins at least two feet apart!

Monday: Yard Waste/Cardboard Pickup
Tuesday: South of Rte.50, West of Rte.13
Wednesday: North of Rte.50, West of Rte.13
Thursday: South of Rte.50, East of Rte.13
Friday: North of Rte.50, East of Rte.13
Townhouses: Mon., Wed., and Fridays

Holiday schedules will be posted in the Daily Times. Call 410-548-3177, for specific changes.

YARD WASTE:

Branches: Each bundle must be tied together, less than 4 feet long, branches or limbs less than 4 inches in diameter, and weighing less than 40 pounds.

Leaves and Vegetative Materials: Place in plastic or biodegradable bags, not weighing more than 40 pounds and only 25 bags per week.



Please place the following items in your 90 gallon trash bin for regular trash pick up.

They are NOT ACCEPTABLE for Recycling!

- Plastic bags or wrap
- Microwave containers
- Styrofoam
- Paper towels
- Waxed Cardboard (For frozen meat, etc.)
- Aluminum furniture or siding
- Aluminum foil with food on it
- Pots or pans
- Ceramic or pottery items
- Drinking glasses, plates or cookware
- Broken glass
- Light bulbs
- Pesticides containers
- Automotive fluid bottles
- Propane tanks
- Metallic wrapping paper



NO plastic bags or wrap



NO Microwave containers



NO Light bulbs
