<u>Salisbury Skatepark – Rules of Use</u>

HOURS OF OPERATION: 8:00 A.M. TO DUSK (WEATHER & CONDITIONS PERMITTING)

- 1. All skaters <u>must</u> be appropriately registered with the City of Salisbury Department of Community Development. Skaters 18 years of age and older must complete and sign a Waiver and Release form and obtain a Salisbury Skatepark registration sticker. This sticker must be displayed prominently on your skating helmet in order to enter and skate in the park. All skaters under the age of 18 must have the waiver signed by a parent or legal guardian.*
- 2. All skaters must wear appropriate safety gear. **Helmets are mandatory!!** Elbow and knee pads are recommended. Shirt and shoes are required.
- 3. The skatepark is unsupervised; use at your own risk.
- 4. Skatepark is open 8:00 a.m. to dusk, weather and conditions permitting.
- 5. No trespassing or skating is allowed when the Park is closed.
- 6. No skating allowed when the Park is wet.
- 7. Only skateboards, razor and in-line skates are allowed in the Park. No bicycles or foot traffic permitted.
- 8. Spectators are not permitted in the skating area.
- 9. Skater etiquette is expected at all times. Be courteous to other skaters.
- 10. No profane or abusive language is permitted. Recklessness and/or boisterous behavior is prohibited.
- 11. No glass is permitted in the Park.
- 12. No alcohol or drugs are permitted on City property.
- 13. No smoking is permitted in the Park. Electronic cigarette devices shall be considered smoking devices and are prohibited. No tobacco products are permitted in the Park.
- 14. No defacing of skatepark property. Vandals will be subject to incarceration.
- 15. No personal music devices or headphones allowed in the skatepark. Use of amplified music is prohibited.
- 16. Personal property is the responsibility of the skater.
- 17. No food or drinks allowed in the skatepark.
- 18. Animals are prohibited in the skatepark area.

- 19. City reserves the right to close the skatepark to the public, including for programmed events.
- 20. Failure to follow the established rules will be considered trespassing. Violators may be subject to criminal prosecution.

All skaters <u>must</u> wear helmets while in the skatepark, and a Salisbury Skatepark registration sticker must be displayed on the helmet. A liability waiver form must be signed by all skaters and/or parents/LEGAL GUARDIANS* of children under 18 years of age.

*LEGAL GUARDIANS are those individuals who have been given the LEGAL authority to make decisions on behalf of a minor. Friends of the family, non-parent relatives, etc. who are in temporary custody of a minor may NOT claim legal guardianship. Salisbury Skatepark registration stickers may also be obtained by mail. Simply download the <u>Skatepark Use Agreement – Assumption of Risk & Waiver and Release</u> form, fill out the form completely, and mail it to the Community Development Department at the address shown above. City staff will review the waiver form to ensure all necessary information is provided, and will mail you the registration sticker. Please be sure to include a working phone number on the form so that we can contact you if we have any questions. A separate Waiver and Release form will be required for each skater in the household, and each skater will receive a registration sticker for their skating helmet.
