**(Robbery Investigation-BB&T Bank)**

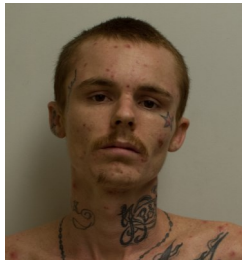
One suspect has been identified, located, arrested, and charged as a result of a robbery that occurred on June 17, 2017 at BB&T Bank.

On June 17, 2017, at approximately 9:00 am, members of the Salisbury Police Department responded to BB&T Bank located at 2400 N. Salisbury Boulevard for a report of a robbery. Bank employees stated that an unmasked suspect had entered the bank, displayed a note and demanded money.

Further investigation revealed that upon entering the bank the suspect displayed a note that demanded money from the bank employee. The bank employee gave the suspect an undisclosed amount of money and the suspect fled the bank on foot. Investigators were assisted by the Worcester County Sheriff's Office K-9 Unit which conducted a track for the suspect. The track was unsuccessful. There were no injuries reported during the incident. Detectives were able to review bank surveillance footage as well as surveillance footage from surrounding businesses, and discovered that there was a single suspect involved in the incident.

Upon additional review of video footage from the bank and surrounding areas, investigators were able to positively identify the suspect as Steven Michael Ewell of Rising Sun, MD. During the early afternoon hours on June 17, 2017 detectives obtained an arrest warrant charging Ewell with the bank robbery.

On June 19, 2017, with the assistance of the Capitol Area Regional Fugitive Task Force, Ewell was located in Crisfield, MD and arrested without incident. Ewell was transported to the Wicomico County Detention Center where he is being held pending an initial appearance.
