October 21, 2017
(Shooting Investigation)

During the early morning hours, detectives initiated an investigation into a shooting that sent a 33 year old male victim to the hospital.

On October 21, 2017, at approximately 00:52 a.m. Salisbury Police Officers and detectives responded to 821 West Main Street Salisbury, Maryland to investigate a reported shooting. The victim was immediately transported to Peninsula Regional Medical Center by Salisbury EMS for medical care and unable to be interviewed.

Further investigation revealed that the 33 year old male sustained a serious and potentially life-threatening gunshot wound to the abdomen. Reports indicate that the victim and suspect had a brief conversation when the suspect produced a handgun firing one shot at the victim. The suspect then fled the area in an unknown direction.

SUSPECT: Black male, approximately 6'00, wearing light colored denim jacket and pants

Salisbury Police Officers and detectives responded and immediately began a search for the suspect. The search was unsuccessful and so far the suspect has not been identified. The victim was treated at Peninsula Regional Medical Center and remains in critical but stable condition.
