The City Parks and Recreation Committee shall consist of five (5) to nine (9) members and one (1) city council representative. The members are appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the City Council for three (3) year terms (Resolution No. 2525 on July 27, 2015). The City Park Committee shall elect a chairman, vice-chairman, and secretary from among its membership. The chairperson shall head the committee's affairs. The Director of Public Works shall serve as the staff contact for the City Park Committee.

The Committee's purpose is to (1) provide advice to the Mayor on the current needs and future development of city parks and public recreation, (2) receive and review all gifts and donations for the city's parks and recreation programs, (3) to advice on the acquisition, development, operation, and maintenance of public parks, playgrounds, recreational centers, and other areas to promote and preserve the health and general welfare of the people of the City of Salisbury, (4) to provide a forum for the public to express their views related to city parks, recreation, and other related issues, (5) to promote interest, cooperation, and support among public and private organizations, agencies, and local residents for the city's parks, recreational facilities, and programs, (6) increase awareness of the city parks and recreational programs, (7) review the annual CIP and Budget, (8), advice and assist city staff members in applying for grant funding for projects relating to parks and recreation, and (9) to be a resource and to interact with the Department of Public Works, the Salisbury Police Department, and the City Planning Commission, specific to the city parks and recreation.
