A RESOLUTION

DATED: December 9, 1985

BE IT RESOLVED that a Marina Committee be created for the purpose of consultations with the Mayor and Council on Marina Area matters pertaining to Marina construction, security, promotion, parking, landscaping, dockmaster duties, fee structures for services rendered and general marina operation.

Said Marina Committee shall, without expense to the City, advise and recommend to the Mayor and Council its findings and suggestions.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Public Works Director and the Executive Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to furnish to the Chairman of the Committee such information and assistance pertinent to the work of the Committee as the Mayor shall approve.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the seven (7) members of the Marina Committee shall be appointed for terms of two (2) years and shall meet at regular intervals to discuss the matters pertinent to the work of the Committee. The seven (7) members shall serve without compensation. The seven (7) members of the Committee shall elect a Chairman.


BE IT RESOLVED that the following individuals are hereby appointed for a two (2) year term to the Marina Committee:


BE IT RESOLVED that this Committee shall periodically report to the Mayor and the City Council through the Executive Secretary or through its Chairman its recommendations and findings on all matters under study by the Committee.

BE IT RESOLVED that it shall be the policy of the Mayor and the City Council to refer the study to the Committee those matters under the City's jurisdiction which, in the opinion of the Mayor and Council, will affect the Marina.
