Essential Functions: Coordinates the Safe Streets strategy with local, state, federal, public and private resources, with goals of a heroin reduction strategy, a crime reduction strategy for identifying juvenile offenders, and identifying offenders who are engaged in a variety of violent criminal activity such as but not limited to, weapons violations, crimes against persons or property, and/or drug possession/distribution. Candidate must be good communicators. Candidate must be competent at motivating and mobilizing community leaders/ members with the purpose of formulating and developing neighborhood associations/ watch groups with the aim of working with law enforcement/ other government leadership to reduce and prevent crime, address concerns, and solve problems.

Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities: Candidate must be a positive thinker and possess good communication skills. Must be capable of working in groups to solve problems. Must possess a valid driver's license and pass a drug screen/background investigation.
