**NOTICE OF AMENDMENT TO THE CHARTER
FOR THE CITY OF SALISBURY**

RESOLUTION NO. 692

CHARTER AMENDMENT

A RESOLUTION to amend the Charter with respect to repealing Section SC20-2 Personal Interests and amending the Charter to create an Ethics Commission.

WHEREAS the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Salisbury that conflicting provisions relating to personal interests contained in the Charter and Chapter 2.04 of the City Code should be resolved and that an Ethics Commission should be appointed by the Charter;

WHEREAS the City Council has also concluded that said changes in the charter made by this resolution will benefit the City of Salisbury and its citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted by the City of Salisbury that Article XX Miscellaneous Provisions be amended as follows:


1. That Section SC20-2 Personal Interests is hereby repealed.
2. That Section SC20-2 shall be amended to read:


§SC20-2 Ethics Commission.

There shall be an Ethics Commission which shall be organized as provided in Chapter 2.04 of the City Code. The duties, rules, and regulations of the Ethics Commission shall be set forth in Chapter 2.04 of the Code.

AND be it further enacted by the Salisbury City Council that this Resolution take effect fifty (50) days from and after the date of its final passage, subject to the right of referendum. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to proceed with the posting and publication of this Resolution pursuant to the requirements of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

The above Resolution was introduced and read and passed at the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Salisbury held on this 24th day of January 2000.
