

RESOLUTION NO. 760

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND
CHANGING THE NAME OF THE MAYOR'S DISABILITY COUNCIL TO MAYOR'S
COUNCIL IN SUPPORT OF PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES**

WHEREAS, the Salisbury City Council created the Mayor's Disability Council in 1991, by Resolution, to advise the Mayor and City Council on steps that could be taken to help people with disabilities participate more fully in all aspects of community life; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Mayor's Disability Council recommend that the name of this organization be changed to the Mayor's Council in Support of People with Disabilities because this name would more accurately reflect the mission of this organization; and


WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council agree with this recommendation.


