A. RESOLUTION

#45

Be it resolved that a Central City Commission be created for the purpose of consultation with the Mayor and Council on central business area matters pertaining to parking, bond financing, property acquisition, special tax district rates, and the general betterment of the area;

Said Central City Commission shall without expense to the City, advise and recommend to the Mayor and Council its findings and suggestions.

Be it resolved that the Executive Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to furnish to the Chairman of the Commission such information and assistance pertinent to the work of the commission as the Mayor shall approve.

Be it further resolved that the seven members of the Central City Commission shall be appointed for terms of one and/or two years and shall meet at regular intervals to discuss the above interest of the Central Business Area. The seven members shall serve without compensation.

Be it further resolved that this Commission shall periodically report to the Mayor and City Council through the Executive Secretary its recommendations and findings on all matters under study by the Commission.

Be it further resolved that it shall be the policy of the Mayor and City Council to refer for study to the Commission those matters under the City's jurisdiction which in the opinion of the Mayor and Council will affect the Central Business Area.
