PRESS RELEASE January 22, 2018 (11:25 a.m.) (Armed Robbery Investigation)

Early this morning, Salisbury police officers and detectives initiated an investigation into an armed robbery of an armored truck driver.

At approximately 7:15 a.m. on January 22, 2018, Salisbury police officers and detectives responded to the 1100 block of Mt. Hermon Road (SECU) for a reported armed robbery. The investigation revealed that a male armored truck driver was robbed while filling an ATM machine with cash. The suspects fled the scene on foot towards Rt 50.

Further investigation revealed that the Loomis Armored truck driver arrived at SECU in an effort to fill the ATM machine with currency. While filling the machine, the driver was approached by what was described as 4 male suspects who were all armed with handguns. The suspects immediately demanded currency while bounding the drivers hands. The suspects stole the drivers company issued handgun and stole an undisclosed amount of currency before fleeing on foot.

Wicomico County Sheriff's Office K-9 assisted in the investigation and conducted a K-9 track which did not locate additional evidence or the suspect's. Maryland State Police Aviation Division also assisted in the investigation, but were unable to locate the suspects or additional evidence. As detectives continue this investigation, the Salisbury Police Department requests that anyone that happened to be in the area of SECU on Mt. Hermon Road and Rt 50, during the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:20 a.m. and observed any suspicious behavior to contact the Salisbury Police Department at (410)548-3165 or Crime Solvers (410)548-1776.
