

Recyclable items that
go in the **BLUE BIN**

PAPER



Newspapers, magazines,
phone books, junk mail -
tied or in a paper bag

CARDBOARD

Corrugated cardboard - put it
under your bin to save space for
other recyclables ***except wax
coated boxes and pizza boxes -
they go in the trash**

METAL



Aluminum cans, tin and
steel cans, bi-metal cans
***washed out please**

GLASS



Green, clear, and brown glass
bottles and glass jars
***washed out please**

PLASTIC



Water and soda bottles,
milk jugs, detergent bottle,
narrowneck containers.
Plastics # 1 & #2.
***washed out please**



**No Plastic Bags (even
to group other
recyclables together).
You can recycle these
at your local
grocery store.**

WEEKLY BULK PICKUP

Bulk pickups happen on Mondays in
Salisbury and must be scheduled by
calling 410-548-3177.

YARD WASTE

Yard waste or vegetative
materials pick up is free,
just call to schedule it.



BRANCHES

The City will pick up 3 bundles of
branches per week. Each bundle
must be tied together, measure less
than 4 feet long, be 4 in or less in
diameter, and weigh less than 40
lbs. Bundles that do not meet this
standard can not be picked up.

LEAVES & VEGETATIVE MATERIAL

Please place leaves and vegetative
material in plastic bags not
weighing more than 40 lbs. Do not
place more than 25 bags out
per week.

LARGE ITEMS (not vegetative)

Bulk Pickup of non-vegetative
materials for a minimum fee of \$25
per pick up. There is an additional
charge for appliances (due to
weight and freon content).

The fees are:

Refrigerator or Freezer \$26

Air conditioner \$22

Washer \$6

Dryer or Stove \$4

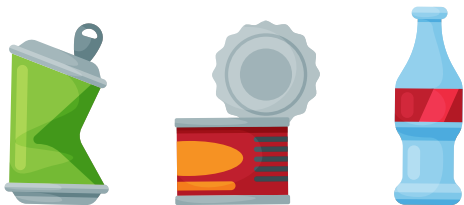

CURBSIDE COLLECTION

RECYCLING

Curbside recycling is a free service to all City of Salisbury residents who utilize the City's once a week, curbside trash collection. City curbside recycling is collected on the same day as curbside trash collection. A City of Salisbury, blue recycling bin is required. To have a free, blue bin delivered, call the City of Salisbury Recycling Support at 410-548-3177. If more than one bin is used, it is strongly recommended that recyclables be separated as much as possible to ensure pick up in a timely and orderly fashion. The container is to be put next to your large trash bin on the same day as your normal trash collection.



PICKUP PROCEDURES

Place recycling bins and trash receptacles on the curb, before 6am, on your designated pick-up day, to ensure timely and orderly pick up. For public safety, recycling bins and trash receptacles must be removed by 11pm, the same day. Please rinse blue bins and other recycling containers weekly. If for some reason your recyclables are not picked-up from your curb, there is a possibility that a non-recyclable somehow ended up in your bin. If this is the case, please reevaluate the curbside materials accepted or call Recycling Support at 410-548-3177.



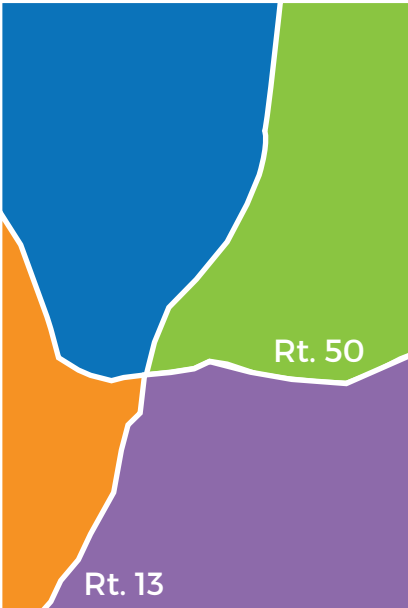
PICKUP Schedule
