

Attached, please find a resolution that will have the effect of accepting the donation of one ADA compliant chess/checkers table from Mr. Wyatt Duncan.

As part of his Eagle Scout Project, Mr. Duncan purchased and will install an ADA compliant chess/checkers table that he would like to donate to the City of Salisbury for peaceful use and enjoyment by residents and visitors.

The purchase cost of the of chess/checkers table, was \$1,372.00. Materials and supplies is averaged at \$75.00 at a total cost of \$1,450.00 (one thousand four hundred and fifty dollars).
