## PRESS RELEASE

December 13, 2018

(Firearms Incident Investigation- Arrest)

During the early evening hours of December 12, 2018 members of the Salisbury Police Department arrested a 36 year old male for unlawful possession of a firearm and reckless endangerment.

On December 12, 2018 at approximately 11:48 a.m., members of the Salisbury Police Department responded to the 200 block of Marshall St. as the result of receiving a 911 call that a victim had been shot. Upon arrival, officers met with a 36 year old male victim with an apparent gunshot wound to his leg as well as a male identified as Kevin Corton. The victim was transported to PRMC where he was treated for his injury, which is not considered life-threatening.

The investigation conducted by members of the Salisbury Police Department Criminal Investigation Division and the Maryland State Police Gang Enforcement Unit revealed that Corton had discharged a firearm resulting in the victim's injury. In addition, Corton was determined to be a prohibited person who should not be in possession of firearms.
