Essential Functions: Performs repairs and preventive maintenance on city vehicles and equipment. Serves as lead mechanic and supervises the garage in the absence of the Supervisor. Must be able to diagnose engine performance and electrical issues. Must be able to fabricate and weld materials to complete repairs. Diagnoses and repairs hydraulic systems, replaces cylinders, seals, and fabricated hoses. Diagnose and repair small engines such as lawn mowers, string trimmers, chainsaws, etc. Must be able to diagnose and repair air conditioning systems, recharges A/C systems. Inspects engines and transmissions for wear and replaces parts such as pistons, rods, gears, valves, and bearings. Must be able to use scan tools to diagnose light and heavy duty cars and trucks.

Education and Experience: HS Diploma or G.E.D. Three years of automotive and heavy equipment repair or equivalent training which includes hydraulic and electrical experience. MD driver's license required. Class "B" CDL must be obtained within 6 months. Completion of a certified welding school and air conditioning certificate to be obtained after hire.
