Yard Waste & Bulk Trash Collection for City Residents

Yard waste is defined as grass clippings, leaves, miscellaneous vegetative material and branches, there is no charge for this service and it is available on Mondays.

To prepare for yard waste collection please;

- ✓ Place grass clippings, leaves and miscellaneous vegetative material in a plastic bag not to exceed 40 pounds, there is a 25 bag maximum per household.
- ✓ Bundle branches in lengths not to exceed 4 feet, keep bundle weight under 40 pounds, branches must be less than 4 inches in diameter, there is a 3 bundle maximum per household.
- ✓ Call 410-548-3177 to schedule a pick-up, requests received by 12PM on Friday will be picked up on the ensuing Monday. (requests placed after 12P on Friday will be picked up the 2nd Monday from the request)

Bulk trash is defined as household items that will not fit into your trash can such as, mattresses, box springs, furniture, TV's, area rugs, etc., there is a \$25 base charge for this service (an additional charge will be incurred for items listed below) this service is available on Mondays.

To prepare for bulk trash collection please;

- ✓ Wrap and seal any item that contains fabric in plastic, this includes but is not limited to; mattresses, bed springs, carpet, sofas, recliners, etc.
- ✓ The \$25 fee permits you to dispose of 3 items, place items curbside by 6A on your scheduled Monday
- ✓ Call 410-548-3110 (the City Finance Department) you will be charged a \$25 fee and your request will be forwarded to the Sanitation Department for a Monday pick up.
- ✓ Bulk pick up items that will incur additional charges to the base charge of \$25;

<u>Free</u> bulk pick-ups are scheduled the entire 3rd week of March and the entire 3rd week of September, items listed above as additional charge items are not included in the free bulk weeks. To participate in the free bulk week please call 410-548-3177 to schedule a pick-up.

The City will not pick up the following items;

*Motor oil *Antifreeze *Paint or paint cans

*Any type of batteries *Tires *Propane tanks

*C & D materials *Items that are excessively heavy or bulky as

*Evictions determined by the Sanitation Superintendent
