A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY ACCEPTING DONATIONS FROM THE BLESS OUR CHILDREN CAMPAIGN FOR THE SANTA'S WORKSHOP PROGRAM AND APPROVING SUCH DONATIONS TO A SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE FUND.

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury's Housing and Community Development Department hosts a Santa's Workshop program every year; and

WHEREAS, Bless Our Children wishes to donate funds to help sponsor this annual program; and

WHEREAS, the donation of funds will be used to purchase gifts, refreshments and equipment used to run the program; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Salisbury, Maryland does hereby accept the donation of funds of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) from Bless Our Children for the Santa's Workshop program, and hereby approves by the votes of at least four-fifths (4/5) of the Council this emergency appropriation of \$3,000.00 to a special revenue fund for the purpose of purchasing toys for children and purchasing refreshments and equipment for the program.

THE ABOVE RESOLUTION was introduced, read and duly passed at the regular meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on this 10th day of December 2018, and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.


