2 3 4 5 6	AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING AN AMENDMENT OF THE FY 2019 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR COSTS OF BILLING REAL PROPERTY TAXES.
7 8 9	WHEREAS, the County has notified the City they will no longer bill City Real Property Taxes; and
10 11 12 13	WHEREAS, the City has received estimates for costs (forms, postage, mailing services, personnel, software implementation, and software licenses) of billing real property taxes totaling eighty-five thousand dollars (\$85,000); and
14 15 16 17	WHEREAS, the Finance Department requires, and this ordinance hereby approves, the addition of a Cashier I/II position to in order to fulfill the duties required for Real Property Billing; and
18 19 20	WHEREAS, the City's FY 2019 budget does not contain an appropriation sufficient to cover the above required services and costs.
21 22 23 24	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND THAT THE City's Fiscal Year 2019 General Fund Budget be and hereby is amended as follows:

28 29 30	BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.
