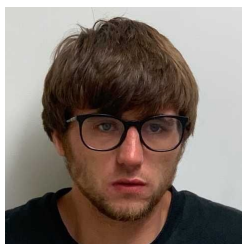

(Drug Arrest)**

During the early morning hours of August 2nd, Salisbury Police arrested a 28 year old male and charged him with felonious possession of heroin.

On August 02, 2019, at approximately 5:00 a.m., Salisbury Police officers were called to respond to the area of E. Church Street and North Salisbury Boulevard for a report of a suspicious vehicle. As officers began to respond to the area they received additional reports that the vehicle was being operated erratically, and had pulled into a parking lot. Officers quickly arrived, located the vehicle parked in the parking lot, and made contact with 28 year old Sean Michael O'Hara, who was operating the vehicle.

As officers made contact with O'Hara he was found to be searching his vehicle frantically, and throwing the contents of the vehicle from one side of the interior to the other. O'Hara continued to act unusually nervous as officers were investigating this incident. Salisbury Police K-9 "Hank" was requested and conducted a scan of O'Hara's vehicle, and alerted to the presence of narcotics within the vehicle. Prior to a probable cause search of the vehicle, O'Hara fled the scene on foot. Officers gave chase and were able to detain him a short distance away. The search of O'Hara's vehicle revealed an undisclosed amount of heroin that led officers to believe he was distributing the heroin.

O'Hara was subsequently arrested and then transported to the Wicomico County Detention Center where he is being held on no bond.
