(Armed Robbery Investigation-ARREST)
Hebron Savings Bank

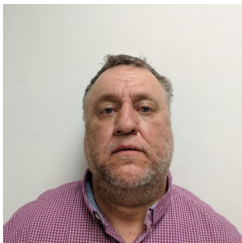
Detectives charge one suspect as a result of the bank robbery that occurred during the afternoon hours on Wednesday February 26, 2020.

On February 26, 2020 at approximately 1:40 p.m., officers and detectives of the Salisbury Police Department responded to Hebron Savings Bank, located at 415 E. Carroll Street for a report of a robbery. Bank employees stated that an un-masked suspect had entered the bank and demanded money.

Further investigation revealed that upon entering the bank, the suspect displayed a note which stated he had a bomb while demanding money from the bank employees. The bank employees gave the suspect an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency. Upon fleeing the bank the suspect encountered a 62 year old female and forcibly removed property from her prior to fleeing the bank in an unknown direction. Detectives were able to capture CCTV still images of the suspect while he was in the bank. There were no injuries reported during the incident.

Upon review of the bank CCTV footage and interviewing witnesses, detectives identified 45 year old Billy Roger Sorrow Jr. as the suspect who robbed the bank. During the late afternoon hours on Friday, February 26, 2020, an arrest warrant was issued for Sorrow, charging him with the bank robbery.

On March 05, 2020 members of the Capitol Area Regional Task Force located and arrested Sorrow in Wilmington, Delaware. Sorrow was served with the arrest warrant and ultimately transported to the Wicomico County Detention Center where he is being held without bond. The investigation is ongoing and police are requesting that anyone with information to contact the Salisbury Police Department at (833)-SBY-CITY.
