Dear Salisbury Landlord,

On June 1, 2020 the Salisbury City Council passed Ordinance No. 2599 to amend Chapter 15.26 Rental of Residential Premises of the Salisbury City Code by adding Subsection 15.26.035 Rent Increases Barred During States of Emergency and authorizing the Mayor to issue such executive orders as necessary to protect tenants from abuse. This legislation and subsequent orders requires that each landlord hand deliver or mail the attached letters to each tenant/unit. These letters must be distributed to each tenant/unit by July 1, 2020. The letter has been translated into Spanish, Haitian Creole and Korean for your convenience and to make sure every tenant understands their rights. Violators of this Order are subject to arrest and a misdemeanor charge per violation.
