## PRESS RELEASE

(Arrests- Assault with Firearm)

Two men charged with assault with firearm after multi-agency investigation.

On August 14, 2020 at approximately 4:21 in the afternoon, members of the Salisbury Police Department responded to the Peninsula Regional Medical Center (PRMC) for the report of a male suffering from an apparent gunshot wound to his back. Officers and detectives met with 36 year old Adrian Wilson, of Salisbury, MD, who advised that he had been in the area of Tilghman Street wherein he was approached by a black male suspect who attempted to rob him. The suspect allegedly pulled out a handgun and fired the handgun at Mr. Wilson multiple times, ultimately striking him in the back. Mr. Wilson then sought immediate treatment at PRMC.

On September 2, 2020 detectives of the Salisbury Police Department met with 28 year old Dajour Waters, of Salisbury, MD, at the Wicomico County Sheriff's Office. Mr. Waters advised detectives that on August 14, 2020 he was approached by a black male suspect in the area of Tilghman Street. The suspect allegedly displayed a handgun and fired it at him striking him in the right leg. Mr. Waters then left the area on foot.

The investigation conducted by members of the Salisbury Police Department Criminal Investigation Division and Wicomico County Sheriff's Office Community Action Team revealed that Mr. Wilson and Mr. Waters are familiar with each other and that on August 14, 2020 the two men allegedly exchanged gunfire following an argument that occurred in the area of Tilghman Street.

On September 4, 2020 at approximately 10:30 in the morning, Mr. Wilson was arrested without incident by the Capital Area Regional Fugitive Task Force (CARFTF) in the area of the 200 block of Cedar Way, Salisbury. At approximately 3:20 in the afternoon that same day, Mr. Waters was arrested, without incident, by members of the Salisbury Police Department Criminal Investigation Division and members of the Wicomico County Sheriff's Office Community Action Team in the area of E. College Avenue and Pierce Avenue in Salisbury.

Both men were transported to the Salisbury Police Department and later released to the custody of the Wicomico County Detention Center where they had initial appearances before a District Court Commissioner.
