October 12, 2021 (Investigations -Shots Fired and Assault with Firearm)

Detectives are currently investigating incidents of a shots fired and an assault with firearm that both occurred early Sunday morning.

On October 10, 2021 at approximately 2:38 in the morning, officers of the Salisbury Police Department were dispatched to the 500 block of Emory Court (Parkwood Apartments) for the report of multiple gunshots in the parking lot. Upon their arrival, officers discovered three vehicles that had sustained damage apparently caused by gunshots. There were no reports of anyone sustaining any physical injuries during this event.

During the investigation, officers located and recovered numerous items of evidentiary value to include a semi-automatic handgun.

Shortly after the investigation at the Parkwood Apartments officers and detectives responded to the 700 block of Hemlock Street at approximately 3:28 in the morning in reference to a shooting that had just occurred. Upon their arrival, officers met with a 30-year-old male victim who was suffering from apparent gunshot wounds.

Through the course of the investigation, officers and detectives spoke with the victim who alleged that he had been walking in the area of the 700 block of Hemlock Street just prior to the call to police when he received his injuries. The victim was not able to provide any further information as to how he received his injuries.

The victim was transported to Tidal Health at Peninsula Regional where he was treated for non-life-threatening injuries.

Theses investigations are ongoing and the Salisbury Police Department requests anyone with information regarding these incidents to contact the Salisbury Police Department Criminal Investigation Division at (410) 548-3165.
