## Sustainability Advisory Committee “Green Team” Meeting Minutes

A Sustainability Advisory Committee meeting was held electronically on Wednesday, December 1st, 2021 at 5:30 pm via Zoom. Discussion included:

1. Minutes from the October and November meetings were discussed. Ryan moved to approve the minutes, Marina seconded, and the vote was unanimous to approve both sets of minutes.
2. Introduced some new (soon-to-be-official) members: Noah Bressman and Megan Outten
3. The committee discussed potential plastic bag ban legislation. Elise described that the committee will be talking with other sustainability professionals from other communities that have implemented bag bans to learn about what they learned and what strategies they found to be the most effective when communicating about the plastic bag bans. The committee also discussed ideas for how to provide more reusable bags for community members.
4. The committee also discussed the recent Green House Gas Inventory, the upcoming December Newsletter, green gift ideas, and the upcoming partnership with BEACON for community engagement in the Spring.
