The City Council convened in a hybrid Work Session (in person and on Zoom Conferencing Video) on December 6, 2021. Upon the adjournment of the Work Session at 5:02 p.m., President Heath called the Special Meeting to order.

ADOPTION OF LEGISLATIVE AGENDA

Mr. Boda moved, Ms. Jackson seconded, and the vote was unanimous (5-0) to approve the Special Meeting agenda as presented.

ORDINANCE – presented by City Attorney Michael Sullivan

- **Ordinance No. 2698**- 2nd reading- approving an amendment of the FY2022 General Fund budget to adjust the Salisbury Police Department’s pay plan for the purpose of recruiting and retaining experienced officers and to be competitive with area agencies

Ms. Jackson moved, Ms. Gregory seconded, and the vote was unanimous (5-0) to approve Ordinance No. 2698 for second reading.

Ms. Jackson reflected on her ability to walk the parade. She encouraged everyone to give blood or donate to the Delmarva Blood Bank.


Ms. Blake reiterated the need for people to give blood.

Ms. Gregory encouraged those who were eligible to get their booster or vaccine.


President Heath asked everyone to share the blood alert on his Facebook page to get the word out. Mr. Heath and his family also enjoyed the parade.
