Salisbury Police recover a handgun and arrest five suspects for CDS related charges.

Earlier in February of 2022 members of the Salisbury Police Department received information from concerned members of the community about narcotics transactions allegedly taking place in and around the 200 block of Marshall Street. SPD's Community Oriented Policing (C.O.P.) unit began to investigate the matter.

On February 24, 2022 at approximately 1:30 in the afternoon, officers observed a vehicle depart from a residence on the 200 block of Marshall Street. Shortly thereafter, officers observed an occupant of the vehicle commit a traffic infraction. Officers were able to safely conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle in question in the area of Naylor Street and N. Salisbury Boulevard.

A probable cause search was conducted on the vehicle wherein an amount of suspected heroin consistent with the intent to distribute was recovered by officers. The 30-year-old driver, Monique Windsor and the 39-year-old front seat passenger, Kevin Corton, were both placed under arrest without incident, transported to the Salisbury Police Department and later released to the Wicomico County Detention Center for initial appearances before a District Court Commissioner.

As the investigation unfolded, additional information was developed that illegal narcotics were also being distributed out of a residence on the 500 block of Buena Vista Avenue. At approximately 3:00pm that same afternoon officers and detectives conducted simultaneous traffic stops on two separate vehicles observed leaving the Buena Vista Avenue location. The vehicle stops were conducted in the areas of Snow Hill Road and Edgar Drive and in the parking lot of the Royal Farms, 901 Snow Hill Road, respectively.

Probable cause searches were conducted on both vehicles and their occupants. The vehicle occupied by 22-year-old Nicholas Garnett and 30-year-old Kimberly Worley revealed evidence of cocaine use and a .40 caliber handgun magazine containing live ammunition. The vehicle occupied by 36-year-old Franklin Dunn yielded a quantity of suspected heroin, suspected crack cocaine, and suspected powdered cocaine consistent with the intent to distribute. Mr. Garnett, Ms. Worley, and Mr. Dunn were each placed under arrest without incident, transported to the Salisbury Police Department and later released to the Wicomico County Detention Center for initial appearances before a District Court Commissioner.

Members of the Salisbury Police Department presented applications for search and seizure warrants to a judge of the Circuit Court for two residential dwellings, one within the 200 block of Marshall Street and the other within the 500 block of Buena Vista Avenue. The applications were signed and members of the Salisbury Police Department shortly thereafter served the search warrants on those residences.

As a result of the search and seizure warrants and arrests over 500 individual packets of heroin, suspected powdered cocaine, suspected crack cocaine, and paraphernalia were seized along with \$9,000.00 of US currency all consistent with the intent to distribute controlled dangerous substances.

Police personnel also located and seized a loaded .40 caliber semi-automatic handgun and ammunition. A records search was conducted on the handgun and it was not found to be stolen. Investigators are continuing their investigation related to the handgun in an effort to determine ownership and any connection to other crimes in the region.
