# The Human Rights Advisory Committee (HRAC) met at 6:00p.m. virtually using Google Meet

## **Call to Order**

The meeting was called to order at 6:27p.m. by Mark Decker and began with introductions of everyone in attendance. The Committee welcomed Kevin "Tyler" Anderson as a recent applicant to join HRAC.

### **Last Meeting Minutes**

The meeting minutes from June were acknowledged and one correction was mentioned. A motion to approve the minutes after the discussed correction was brought forth by Mr. Doughty and seconded by Mr. Feliciano. The motion was carried by a unanimous vote in favor.

Mr. Pheasant added that the committee should keep an eye on the international students and their ability to return to SU pending new requirements.

## **Committee Membership**

Members are to submit position descriptions to Ms. English prior to the next meeting so they can be compiled and reviewed in August. Ms. English will also do some research to locate pre-existing descriptions.

Benjamin Pheasant is scheduled to be appointed to the HRAC per Council meeting on July 13th. Remaining applicants will be invited to the August meeting.
