

# RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMITS

Residential Permit Parking is designated by signs placed on the permit parking only streets. Parking on these streets is restricted to only residents and their guests, and a permit for these locations is free of charge.

A permit (or guest pass) issued by the Parking Authority must be properly displayed to prevent a parking citation.

## HOW TO APPLY

1. Download and complete a Parking Permit Application from the City's website or pick one up at the Parking Authority office.
2. Bring your completed application to the Parking Authority office.
3. In addition to the application, you must bring a valid Driver's License, registration of vehicle, and copy of your lease, deed, or utility bills. All items must show the applicant's name.

## WHAT YOU'LL GET

- **Residential Parking Permit Hangtag:** This permit is street-specific, which means that you are permitted to park in front of your residence only.
- **One Permanent Visitor Permit Hangtag:** This permit is also street-specific.
- **Ten Temporary One-Day Visitor Permit Hangtags:** These permits are also street-specific and are only valid if the date of visitation is written on the permit, in ink. No exceptions.

## IMPORTANT REMINDERS!

- All permits must be displayed hanging from the rearview mirror or the dashboard.
- Residential and Permanent Visitor Permits must be renewed by September 30th of each year for homeowners and renters by the renewal date of the lease. Proof of a renewed lease is required for all renters.
- Additional Temporary One-Day Visitor Permits can be purchased for \$2.50 each at the Parking Authority Office.
- Permits are to be returned to the office when no longer needed or valid.
