Department: The Infrastructure & Development Department is responsible for administering all infrastructure and development projects in the City. The Department is the one-stop-shop for Developers entering the City to have projects reviewed through all phases including Planning, Engineering, Traffic Control, Building Permits, Fire Marshal and Construction Inspection.

Profile: Conducts site inspections for projects including site work, utilities (water, sewer, storm drains), concrete structures, paving, curb, gutter, sidewalks, stormwater management facilities, and franchised utility work. Reviews and evaluates specifications and drawings, prepares and conducts pre-construction meetings, verifies completion of all pre-construction paperwork, checks placement of traffic control devices to ensure compliance with MUTCD. Prepares inspection reports and coordinates completion of project documentation.

Preferred Education: High school diploma or GED required. Must be able to communicate clearly and concisely both orally and in writing.

Preferred Experience: Two years of experience in public works project management, utility construction, stormwater management or construction engineering.

Requirements/Certifications: Valid State of Maryland Driver's License
Maryland Responsible Personnel Certificate for Sediment and Erosion Control
