Profile:

Collect, collate, analyze and evaluates crime data to discover developing trends, patterns, and changes in criminal activity. Read reports daily to obtain information for crime analysis, collect and collate data, updating fields in the records management system as needed for use in crime analysis. Identify crime trends within the City. Perform analysis and create information products to include maps, crime bulletins and reports on a timely basis. Assist in the development and management of quality control procedures for the Police Department's database. Respond to requests for reports related to crime data, statistics, and other information both in house and from the public, to include media and other agencies. Prepare monthly, quarterly, yearly and multi-year reports on crime data. Review calls for service daily to ensure addresses have been matched to the geographical information system file, and update files as needed.

Preferred Education: Bachelor's degree in mathematics, geographic information systems or computer science

Preferred Experience: Or two years of law enforcement experiences in crime analysis; Or equivalent training, education and/or experience.

Requirements/Certifications: Proven ability to effectively communicate, prioritize, analyze, interpret and summarize crime data and make reasonable and logical judgements. Must pass a background check and drug screen.
