ORDINANCE NO. 2417

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING AN AMENDMENT OF THE FY 2017 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR ADDITIONAL FIRE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL AND PROMOTIONS.

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has a need for an additional four (4) Firefighter/Emergency Medical Technicians; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has a need to add two (2) Captains to its current allocation; and

WHEREAS, there are insufficient funds available in the FY17 Fire Department Budget to fund the additional four (4) positions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND THAT THE City's Fiscal Year 2017 General Fund Budget be and hereby is amended as follows:

- 1) Increase Current Surplus Available (01000- 469810) by \$116,422.16
- 2) Increase Fire Department Budget by \$116,422.16

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on this 27 day of February 2017, and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, was finally passed by the Council on the 20 day of March, 2017.
