

ORDINANCE NO. 2422

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING A BUDGET AMENDMENT OF THE FY17 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE INSURANCE PROCEEDS RECEIVED IN FY17 TO AID IN THE PURCHASE OF A NEW VEHICLE FOR THE POLICE FLEET.

WHEREAS, Salisbury Police Animal Control Unit #AC1, a 2003 Ford F150 King Cab, VIN 1FTRX17WX3NA30648 was involved in a motor vehicle accident and deemed a total loss; and

WHEREAS, the replacement of the animal control vehicle will allow SPD to maintain a sufficient number of Animal Control vehicles to effectively patrol all areas of the City; and

WHEREAS, SPD is requesting the Commission of Accreditation refund check in the amount of \$997.18 be placed in the SPD Police Services, Vehicle Account, 21021-577025; and

WHEREAS, SPD will utilize the funds appropriated from the insurance adjustment and purchase a new Animal Control vehicle.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the City's Fiscal Year 2017 General Fund Budget and is hereby, amended as follows:


- 1) Increase Insurance Proceeds (01000-456935) by \$997.18
- 2) Increase the Police Department budget by \$997.18

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on this 24 day of April, 2017, and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, was finally passed by the Council on the 8 day of May, 2017.

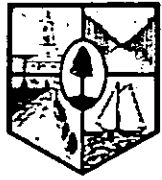
