

ORDINANCE NO. 2476

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING AN AMENDMENT OF THE FY 2018 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL POSITION ALLOCATIONS FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL.

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has a need to add an additional one (1) Firefighter/Emergency Medical Technician; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has a need to add one (1) Fire Inspector I (civilian) to its current allocation; and


WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds available in the FY18 Fire Department Budget to fund the additional positions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND THAT THE City's Fire Department position allocations be amended by adding:

- 1) Adding one (1) Firefighter/Emergency Medical Technician
- 2) Adding one (1) Fire Inspector I (civilian)

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on this 26th day of February 2018, and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, was finally passed by the Council on the 12th day of March, 2018.


