

ORDINANCE NO. 2500

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING AN AMENDMENT OF THE CITY'S CAPITAL PROJECT FUND BUDGET TO REALLOCATE FUNDING FOR THE JOHNSON LAKE DAM IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2423 appropriated funds for the FY 2018 budget; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2423 allocated an appropriation of \$240,000 for the Johnson Lake Dam Improvements project; and

WHEREAS, funding for the project in Schedule B of Ordinance 2423 was allocated as \$ 156,948 from Stormwater Pay GO and \$ 83,052 from reallocation of prior year bonds; and


WHEREAS, a budget amendment is requested to accomplish the reallocation of prior year bonds as planned for in Ordinance No. 2423.
