

RESOLUTION NO. 2731

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY MARYLAND ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS AWARDED THROUGH THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FROM THE WATERWAY IMPROVEMENT FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,000 FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE PORT OF SALISBURY MARINA.

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Natural Resources has Grant Funds which supports the development, use, and enjoyment of all waters of the State of Maryland for the benefit of the general boating public; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has obtained approval to install a floating dock to safely launch rowing boats and kayaks at the Port of Salisbury Marina; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works desires to complete a pile cap replacement project at the Port of Salisbury Marina; and


WHEREAS, the projects will provide improvements to benefit the general boating public along the Wicomico River; and


WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Natural Resources has awarded two \$5,000 grants each to help fund the floating dock and pile cap replacement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland does hereby accept the grants totaling \$10,000 from the Maryland Department of Natural Resources to be used toward the cost of the floating dock purchase and pile cap replacements at the Port of Salisbury Marina.



MEMORANDUM

Re: DNR Waterway Improvement Fund Grant Acceptance

The City has been awarded two waterway improvement grants in the amount of \$5,000 each from the Maryland Department of Natural Resources DNR Waterway Improvement Fund.

The first \$5,000 grant will go toward funding the installation of a floating dock and kayak launch to be constructed at the Port of Salisbury Marina. The City has obtained a State waterway permit and final approval of specifications by the State to put the contract out to bid to purchase the dock. The City has \$40,000 in additional grant funding toward purchase of the floating dock and kayak launch. The City has funds budgeted and will perform the installation to meet requirements of the grant for matching funding.

The second \$5,000 grant will go towards replacing the original (up to thirty year old) metal pile caps with plastic caps. The pile caps help protect the piles from deterioration. The City has obtained DNR approval of quotes for purchase of 457 black plastic cone shaped pile caps. Funding is available to supplement the grant funds to purchase the pile caps. City staff will perform the installation.
