

**Resolution No. 2745**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION OF THE EASTERN SHORE FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXPENDING GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$600.00.

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury applied for funds through the CFES'S Small Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the CFES has awarded the City of Salisbury funds in the amount of \$600.00; and

WHEREAS, these funds shall be used for the YDAC UnitesBY Kick-Off Event and Community BBQ; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury must enter into a grant agreement with CFES defining how these funds must be expended; and


WHEREAS, § 7-29 of the Salisbury City Charter forbids the Mayor from entering into a contract that requires an expenditure not appropriated or authorized by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, appropriations necessary to execute the purpose of this grant must be made upon the recommendation of the Mayor and the approval of four-fifths of the Council of the City of Salisbury;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland does hereby appropriate the necessary funds and authorize Mayor Jacob R. Day to enter into a grant agreement with CFES and expend the awarded funds accordingly.




Dear Honorable Day:

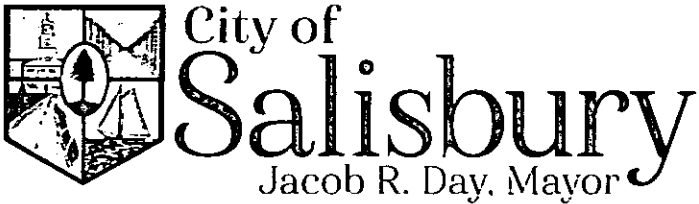
