
WHEREAS, the SPD has the desire to add these tires to the GYM equipment; and

THIS RESOLUTION was duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on October 9, 2017, and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.

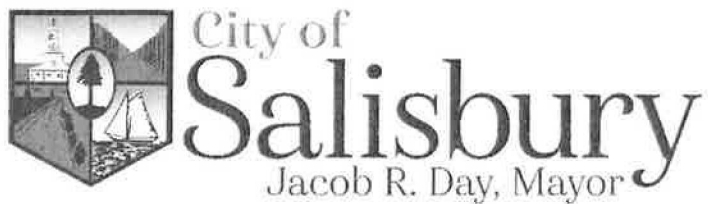
