A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000.00 THROUGH THE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION OF THE EASTERN SHORE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING A MCGRUFF SAFE KIDS TOTAL IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM LAW ENFORCEMENT CUSTOM IDENTIFICATION CARD AND DIGITAL FINGERPRINT DEVICE.

WHEREAS, this device will be utilized at National Night Out and other community events in the city to create digital fingerprints and identification cards for children, and

WHEREAS, the digital fingerprints and identification cards will be provided to parents at no cost as a public service, and


WHEREAS, the total cost of this device is \$6,995.00 and that SPD has surplus funds available in salary accounts in the amount of \$1,995.00 to combine with grant funds to make the purchase, and

WHEREAS, SPD requests that all appropriated funds from grant and salary be placed in SPD account, Equipment & Salary, 21021-546012 in order to make this purchase, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the awarded funds in the amount of \$5,000.00 (five thousand dollars) are accepted and shall be utilized by the Salisbury Police Department.

THIS RESOLUTION was duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on December 11, 2017 and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.

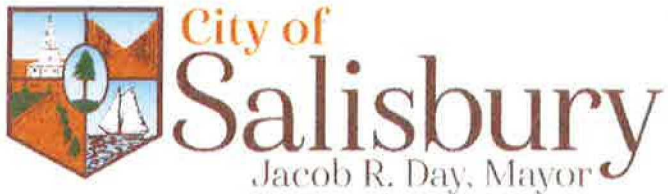
