A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY TO APPROVE THE CONSTRUCTION OR REHABILITATION PROJECT OF A MINIMUM OF FOUR HOMES IN THE GREATER CHURCH STREET NEIGHBORHOOD TO BE SOLD TO LOW OR VERY LOW INCOME FAMILIES BY HABITAT FOR HUMANITY OF WICOMICO COUNTY, INC. OVER THE NEXT TWO YEARS.


WHEREAS, Habitat for Humanity of Wicomico County, Inc., a nonprofit organization, proposes to undertake the project described above (the "Project"); and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland, does hereby express approval of the Project, as described above.


