A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ACCEPTING FIVE, 40-FOOT MARYLAND TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION BUSES.

WHEREAS, in support of the National Folk Festival in 2018, the Maryland Transit Administration agreed to give the City of Salisbury five, 40-foot buses; and


WHEREAS, these buses were to be used during the 2018 National Folk Festival in support of site safety; and

WHEREAS, due to an oversight, the five buses were never officially accepted by the City of Salisbury as a donation; and





In 2018, the State of Maryland donated five, 40-foot, Maryland Transit Administration buses to the City of Salisbury for use during the National Folk Festival. There was an oversight in not officially accepting these buses through a resolution in 2018. This resolution will officially accept the buses to become City property.

The City has evaluated the buses and unfortunately they are deemed to be too expensive and too large to utilize further. At the next Council Meeting we will be requesting to surplus these vehicles.
