ORDINANCE NO. 2739

AN ORDINANCE THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND TO ACCEPT A DONATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,500 FROM THE SALISBURY SKATEPARK COMMITTEE, INC. AND TO SIMULTANEOUSLY APPROVE A BUDGET AMENDMENT TO THE GRANT FUND BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE THESE FUNDS FOR ELIGIBLE EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF PHASE 2B OF THE SALISBURY SKATEPARK.

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury has a large number of youth (and many adults) that love to skateboard; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to provide an improved and expanded public skatepark for its citizens that is free of charge, so that they may continue to enjoy what is becoming an increasingly popular sport; and

WHEREAS, the expansion, known as Salisbury Skatepark, Phase 2B, will further build upon the commitment that our community has made to our local youth and citizenry at large, by providing yet another amenity to serve health, social and recreational needs; and

WHEREAS, in October 2021 the City received a Community Parks & Playgrounds (CP&P) grant from the Maryland Department of Natural Resources for the Salisbury Skatepark, Phase 2B in the amount of \$162,801; and

WHEREAS, the City allocated the grant to the cost of the Salisbury Skatepark, Phase 2B, but a change order has exceeded the allowable budget for the project; and

WHEREAS, the Salisbury Skatepark Committee, Inc. has offered to donate an additional \$9,500 to expand the budget for Phase 2B of the Skatepark, thereby enabling change order #9 under contract RFP 03-14 to be executed and

WHEREAS, appropriations necessary to execute the purpose of this donation must be made upon the recommendation of the Mayor and the approval of four-fifths of the Council of the City of Salisbury.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENANCTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> Mayor Jacob R. Day, on behalf of the City of Salisbury, is hereby authorized to accept a donation in the amount of \$9,500 from the Salisbury Skatepark Committee, Inc., which donation will be appropriated for expenditures related to the Salisbury Skatepark, Phase 2B.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

Section 2. The City of Salisbury's Grant Fund Budget be and hereby is amended as follows:

- (a) Increase Skatepark Donations Revenue Account No. 12800–456415–73039 by \$9,500.
- **(b)** Increase Skatepark Construction Expense Account No. 12800–513026–73039 by \$9,500.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

- <u>Section 3</u>. It is the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that each provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed independent of all other provisions herein.
- <u>Section 4.</u> It is further the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid,


unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable under applicable Maryland or federal law, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudged and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall remain and shall be deemed valid and enforceable.

<u>Section 5</u>. The recitals set forth hereinabove are incorporated into this section of the Ordinance as if such recitals were specifically set forth at length in this Section 5.

<u>Section 6</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury held on the 12 day of September, 2022 and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, in the meantime, was finally passed by the Council of the City of Salisbury on the 26 day of September, 2022.
