General Statement of Job

Under the direction of assigned supervisor, performs general facility maintenance as needed in areas including, but not limited to, plumbing, carpentry, painting, and equipment maintenance and repair; performs other duties as assigned.

Specific Duties and Responsibilities

Essential Functions:

1. Assist with painting and other maintenance upkeep;
2. Help build and maintain exhibits;
3. Conduct general plumbing duties within zoo;
4. Perform simple electrical tasks;
5. Complete general carpentry repairs;
6. Run monthly power equipment checks for proper working condition;
7. Assists with setting up special displays;
8. Maintain clean work area, tools and equipment;
9. Keeps supervisor informed of unusual or detrimental conditions including equipment malfunctions and process problems;
10. Assist with landscaping duties as needed; including, but not limited to mowing, tree and shrub trimming and plantings;
11. Performs other duties as assigned.

Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

1. Working knowledge of City policies and procedures.
2. Act as a representative of the City of Salisbury to the public.
3. Safely operate heavy vehicles, tools, and equipment.
4. Accurately follow written and oral instructions.
5. Effectively communicate and maintain effective working relationships with other staff members and members of the public.

Required Education and Experience
