The City Council convened in a Special Work Session at 5:40 p.m. Council President Boda called the Special Work Session to order and the following two items were presented.

Ordinance to authorize the Mayor to enter into a contract with the Boys & Girls Clubs of Metropolitan Baltimore, Inc. to accept \$350,000 in funds to construct the Truitt Community Center Expansion Project

HCDD Director Ron Strickler explained the City recently entered into a contract with the Boys & Girls Club of Metropolitan Baltimore to operate a youth and teen after school and summer camp program at the Truitt Community Center. Part of the agreement and the extension they recently reached was to receive the \$350,000 from the Boys & Girls Club. They received a grant through the State Board of Public Works, and the City had to extend a term of 15 years with the Boys & Girls Club. The agreement would approve the required contract and budget amendment. Council reached unanimous consensus to advance the legislation to legislative session.

Ordinance to authorize the Mayor to transfer from the Revolving fund, transfer from the Water Sewer Fund, and appropriate funds for the Raw Water Line at Naylor Mill Project in the Water Sewer Capital Project Fund


DID Director Rick Baldwin requested the budget amendment for \$1.2 million to complete construction of the Raw Water Main to connect Well #1 to the new Well #3 to the Paleo Water Treatment Plant. The current raw water line was built over a timber trestle about 50 years ago and damaged during a recent storm. Council reached unanimous consensus to advance the legislation to legislative agenda.
