

You must be registered to vote in Maryland and have your primary residence within the corporate boundaries of the City of Salisbury in order to receive a mail-in ballot for the City of Salisbury election. If you are not registered to vote in Maryland and want to register, go to the state website at [elections.maryland.gov](https://elections.maryland.gov) or visit the Wicomico County Board of Elections office.

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## How to ask for a mail-in ballot

Return your completed signed form to the county board of elections. You can return it by mail, fax, or email. You can also drop it off in person.

Make sure to return this form by the correct deadline listed below.

## How will you receive your mail-in ballot?

- The most common way to receive your ballot is by mail. We can mail your ballot to any address you want. You will also receive a return envelope with prepaid postage.
  - We can email you a ballot so you can print your ballot. Choosing to receive your ballot by email will require you to use your own return envelope. You will also need to use your own postage if returning your ballot by mail.
  - You can also pick it up in person, or have someone pick it up:
    - If you want someone to pick up your ballot for you, you need to provide a *Designation of Agent* form. Get this form at the county election office or online at [www.salisbury.md](https://www.salisbury.md).
    - The person who picks up your ballot must be at least 18 years of age, a registered voter in the City of Salisbury, and cannot be a candidate on your ballot. You can also have this person return your voted ballot to the county election office. This person must sign a form to show that he or she handled the ballot properly.
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## Deadlines for returning this form

Your deadline depends on how you return this form, and on how you want to receive your ballot.

- If you want your election office to mail you a ballot:
    - Make sure this form is in our office by 4:30 pm on Tuesday, October 31, 2023.
    - Or send us this form by email or fax by 11:59 pm on Tuesday, October 31, 2023.
  - If you want to print your emailed ballot:
    - Make sure this form is in our office by 5:00 pm on Friday, November 3, 2023.
    - Or send us this form by email or fax by 11:59 pm on Friday November 3, 2023.
    - To email this form, print the form, sign it, scan it, and attach it to the email. We do not accept digital or electronic signatures. You must sign this form by hand.
