

1	ORDINANCE NO. 2809		
2 3 4 5 6 7	AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND TO ACCEPT STATE OF MARYLAND – MARYLAND STATE POLICE GRANT FUNDS FOR LICENSE PLATE READER EQUIPMENT FOR THE SALISBURY POLICE DEPARTMENT.		
8 9	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the State of Maryland – Maryland State Police has grant funds available to local law enforcement agencies for the purchase of License Plate Reader Systems; and		
10 11 12 13	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the Maryland Coordination and Analysis Center has designated grant funds in the amount of \$99,633.55 to be reimbursed to the City of Salisbury for the purchase of License Plate Reader System equipment; and		
14 15	<b>WHEREAS</b> , appropriations necessary to execute the purpose of this grant must be made upon the recommendation of the Mayor and the approval of four-fifths of the Council of the City of Salisbury.		
16 17 18 19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:		
20 21 22 23	<u>Section 1</u> . Acting Mayor John R. Heath, on behalf of the City of Salisbury, is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement with the State of Maryland - Maryland State Police for the City's acceptance of grant funds in the amount of \$99,633.55 to be allocated for assistance with the purchase of License Plate Reader System equipment.		
24	Section 2. The City of Salisbury's Grant Fund Budget be and hereby is amended as follows:		
25 26	(a) Increase State of Maryland MD State Police Revenue Account 10500–424000–xxxxx by \$99,633.55.		
27	(b) Increase Equipment Expense Account No. 10500–577030–xxxxx by \$99,633.55		
28 29	BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:		
30 31	Section 3. It is the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that each provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed independent of all other provisions herein.		
32 33 34 35 36	<u>Section 4</u> . It is further the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable under applicable Maryland or Federal law, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudged and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall remain and shall be deemed valid and enforceable.		
37 38	<u>Section 5</u> . The recitals set forth hereinabove are incorporated into this section of the Ordinance as if such recitals were specifically set forth at length in this Section 5.		
39 40 41 42 43	Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.  THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury held on the 15 <sup>th</sup> day of May, 2023 and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance
