

**AS AMENDED ON JUNE 12, 2023
ORDINANCE NO. 2808**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY AUTHORIZING THE
MAYOR TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN
PROJECT AND THE ZONING CODE PROJECT.**

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury is due to update the Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Code; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury determined an additional ~~\$75,000~~ \$30,000 will be required to complete the Comprehensive Plan Project and \$85,000 is required for the Zoning Code Project; and

WHEREAS, funding for the two projects shall be provided by transferring ~~\$160,000~~ \$115,000 in PayGO funds from the Computer Aided Dispatch Project; and

WHEREAS, the appropriations necessary to execute the appropriation of ~~\$160,000~~ \$115,000 as provided hereinabove, must be made upon the recommendation of the Mayor and the approval of four-fifths of the Council of the City of Salisbury.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

Section 1. Acting Mayor John R. Health, on behalf of the City of Salisbury, is hereby authorized to appropriate funds for the Comprehensive Plan project in the amount of ~~\$75,000~~ \$30,000 and the Zoning Code Project in the amount of \$85,000.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

Section 2. The City of Salisbury’s General Capital Project Fund Budget be and hereby is amended as follows:

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

Section 3. It is the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that each provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed independent of all other provisions herein.

Section 4. It is further the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable under applicable Maryland or federal law, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudged and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall remain and shall be deemed valid and enforceable.

Section 5. The recitals set forth hereinabove are incorporated into this section of the Ordinance as if such recitals were specifically set forth at length in this Section 5.


Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury held on the 22nd day of May, 2023 and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, in the meantime, was finally passed by the Council of the City of Salisbury on the 12th day of June, 2023.


