## Winter Weather Tips from the Water Works Dept.

With the weather changing and winter coming, it's important to winterize your home and protect from frozen pipes.

To do so, follow these important steps:

- Protect your pipes from bursting by installing tubular pipe wrap, rolled pipe wrap, and insulation fittings
- When the temperature drops below freezing, let cold water drip from one faucet
- Turn off water from outside spigots, drain all water from the line, and install a spigot cover for the winter season
- Clean out your gutters and clear the roof
- Check and change your air filters
- Keep the thermostat above 55 degrees
