As part of the City's continuing efforts to formulate plans to address the greatest eligible needs by strategic use of the City's yearly allocation of CDBG funding, the City of Salisbury has completed a draft PY 2024-2028

Consolidated Plan, Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice and PY2024 Action Plan.
