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#### A. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY -

The City has determined that it is necessary to amend a previously approved CDBG program year's budget. This change is considered a substantial amendment in accordance with the City's Citizen Participation Plan since the following applies: To carry out an activity that was not previously identified in the plan; and A change in purpose, scope, location, funding, or beneficiaries from one eligible activity to another by more than 50% of the total amount previously authorized.

The amendment to the PY 2023 Annual Action Plan will change the following:

- Cancel Low-Mod Neighborhood Sidewalk Construction and Pedestrian Improvements for \$222,086 and create a new project Waterside Park Improvements with a total budget of \$222,086.
- Cancel Homeless Services Intensive Case Manager for \$19,000 and create a new project Truitt Street Community Center Rehabilitation with a total budget of \$69,000.
- Cancel Anne Street Village Construction/Rehab for \$50,000 and create a new project Truitt Street Community Center Rehabilitation with a total budget of \$69,000.
