

## **Updates from Department of Water Works**



The City of Salisbury's water currently meets all Water Quality Regulations as required by Maryland Department of the Environment and the Environmental Protection Agency. The City has been aware of the new PFAS regulations and has been preparing to install treatment at both Paleo and Park water plants to remove PFAS. The new PFAS rule allows water systems five years to plan, design and find the best solutions for their community. For more information and to view the City's press release,

Open Gym at Truitt Community Center 319 Truitt St., Every Saturday 5-8pm


Open gym days will continue in the new year! Free and open to all. Children under 10 yrs old must be accompanied by an adult. Check this webpage for a schedule of dates and times
